OUTREACH AT THE CHURCH OF ST. LUKE IN THE FIELDS

Guidelines

There is **no entry** to the program before **6:45 pm**. There is another program before ours and we wish to give them the same respect that they give us.

There is **no entry** after **8:00 pm**. **No exceptions.**

Dinner is served at 8:15 pm. Please let staff know if you have any dietary restrictions or food allergies.

We are **not** responsible for personal property brought to the program.

Violence and threats of violence are **not** permitted at St. Luke's.

Weapons of any type will **not** be permitted on St. Luke's property.

Abusive, disrespectful language is **not** permitted at St. Luke's.

Gang clothing, including flags, colored headwear and beads, as well as gang signs are **not** permitted at St. Luke's.

Theft is **not** permitted on St. Luke's property.

Vandalism is **not** permitted anywhere on St. Luke's property.

Hanging out on St. Luke's property, other than for the program and regular Church functions is **not** allowed for participants.

Drugs and alcohol are **not** permitted on St. Luke's property. Anyone suspected of coming to the program while under the influence of drugs or alcohol will be asked to leave.

Smoking is **not** permitted inside any St. Luke's building. There are two "smoke breaks" throughout the evening, one at 7:00 pm and one at 8:00 pm. Youth will be accompanied to the courtyard by staff.

Sexual activity is **not** permitted on St. Luke's property.

Signs of affection are okay and are at the discretion of staff. There is **no** lap sitting, fondling, groping, making out, **no** grinding, **no** piggy back riding, **no** improper touching, etc.

One person is allowed in the restroom at a time.

Please use only one plastic cup, one plate, and one set of utensils during dinner. If you would like seconds on the meal and they are available, please use the same plate as the first helping.

Hanging out is only allowed in designated areas for the program and where staff is available (i.e. gym, cafeteria, and art workshop space).

No rough housing. Please respect each other's space.

You are expected to clean up after yourself after dinner. Please do **not** leave garbage on the floor or on the tables.

Youth who break any of these guidelines will be asked to leave the Youth Program for at least one session. If the incident is deemed serious, youth will be asked to meet with a St. Luke's Youth Program Staff person before they will be allowed to return to the Program. Staff retains the right to terminate a youth from the program for violation of these guidelines and/or any action that jeopardizes another's safety.
