Dear Friends,

Throughout 2010, Episcopal Charities continued its success in providing vital support for programs serving neighbors in need throughout the Diocese of New York. Not only were we able to make 81 grants totaling nearly \$670,000 to parish-based programs, we also helped them to reach new levels of service during these times of accentuated need.

Our basic human needs programs fed hundreds of thousands, helped house the homeless, aided in addiction recovery, and provided many other life-giving services. Our youth grants helped local school children through a host of programs, offering tutoring, music, after-school recreation, and more. In addition, Episcopal Charities helped to advance the *All Our Children* initiative, encouraging churches throughout the Diocese of New York to partner with public schools in their communities.

Through our Sustainability Institute, we offered training specific to each of our two focus areas: youth programs and basic human needs. In youth programs, our 2010 emphasis was on anti-bullying and sexual-abuse prevention. As for basic human needs, our training centered on nutrition and nutrition education for families. These sessions

built upon earlier workshops related to budgeting, volunteer management, record keeping and fundraising.

During 2010, we took important steps in promoting our mission, programs and successes. Our website now features a page dedicated to each of the programs we support, with photos, program descriptions and volunteer opportunities. In addition, we launched Episcopal Charities' *eNews*, helping our programs and supporters to stay abreast of our activities in areas of critical need.

We are very pleased to note that financial contributions to Episcopal Charities held steady in 2010, which stands as testament to the thoughtfulness, caring and generosity of our supporters, especially during challenging economic times. And, as always, a full 100% of public donations that we received were used for direct program support.

We are very gratified that our success in providing well-targeted grants, *and in capacity building*, has encouraged others to help advance our mission of service. With your help and partnership, our efforts will continue to gain momentum. # 2010 Grants Report

In 2010, Episcopal Charities was proud to maintain its focus on the primary work of funding parish-based Basic Human Needs and Youth Programs, as well as expanding and refining efforts to support programs through education and technical assistance. The programs funded by Episcopal Charities address the full spectrum of social service needs faced by the diverse urban, suburban and rural communities of the Diocese of New York. Through grants from Episcopal Charities, 81 programs received financial support: 42 of the programs addressed basic human needs, while 39 offered youth opportunity services.

2010 was also the second year of a special three-year commitment to three programs, each operated collaboratively by two local parishes and addressing different critical community needs in the areas of prison re-entry, immigrant services and feeding. Support of these innovative programs will continue through 2011 to help the programs succeed beyond the grants' conclusion.

In 2010, Episcopal Charities supported the following Basic Human Needs service delivery areas:

# Eligibility and Application for Support

Twice each year, Episcopal Charities invites grant proposals from any Episcopal congregation within the Diocese of New York. Proposals for programs serving **Basic Human Needs** (all programs other than those serving youth) are accepted in the fall of the year preceding the calendar year in which allocations are made. Proposals for **Youth Opportunities Grants** are accepted early in the calendar year for allocations that are made during the period that extends from July of that year through June of the following year.

## Eligibility Requirements

In order to be eligible to receive a grant from Episcopal Charities, programs must meet the following criteria:

- **Congregational Connection:** Programs must be sponsored by, and in partnership with, one or

more Episcopal congregations within the Diocese of New York.

- **Community Outreach:** The program must represent an effort by a local congregation or group of congregations to respond to an identified need affecting members of the community in which the congregation is located.
- **Clients’ Eligibility:** Any person needing the service offered should be eligible to receive it without regard for church membership, faith, or participation in church activities.
- **Program Content:** Services provided may not include religious content, must be non-sectarian and inclusive.
- **Quality and Impact of Program:** Programs should offer high quality services that give promise to change the lives of clients in ways that help them live more productive

and satisfying lives, and should show evidence of sustainability beyond Episcopal Charities funding.

Application materials can be obtained by contacting the office of Episcopal Charities.

Episcopal Charities seeks to make a substantial impact on all of the parish programs that it supports. To achieve this goal, we ordinarily only fund programs where our financial support is a minimum of 10% of the program's operating expenses. Funding typically covers 30-50% of a program's operating expenses.

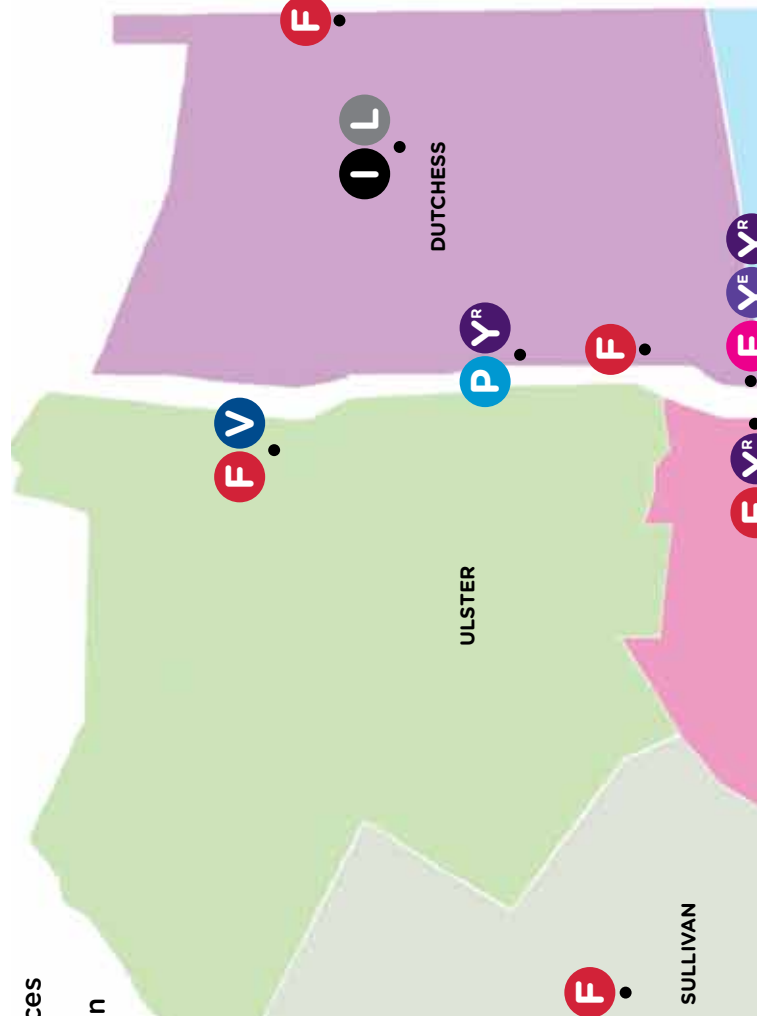
