A Letter from the Bishop and the President

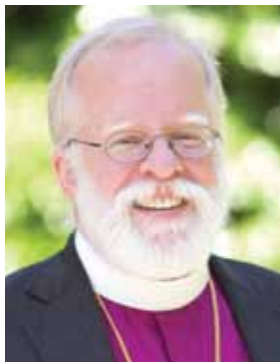
Dear Friends,

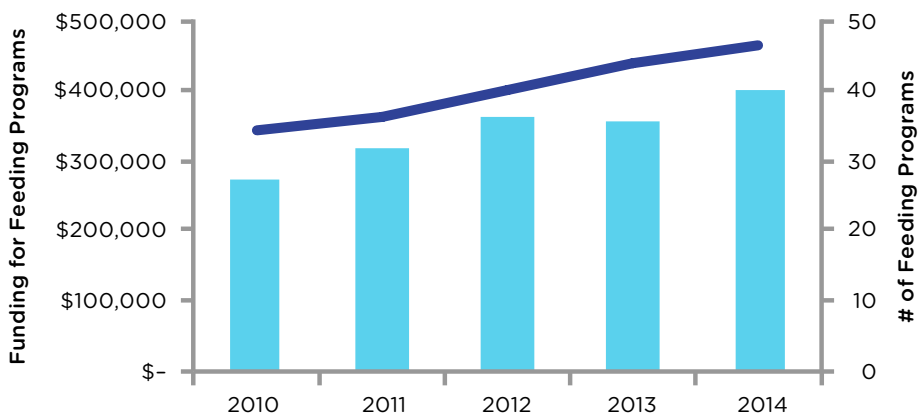

INCREASED FUNDING FOR FEEDING PROGRAMS

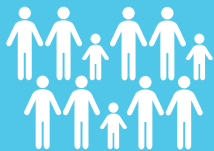


In the last five years,

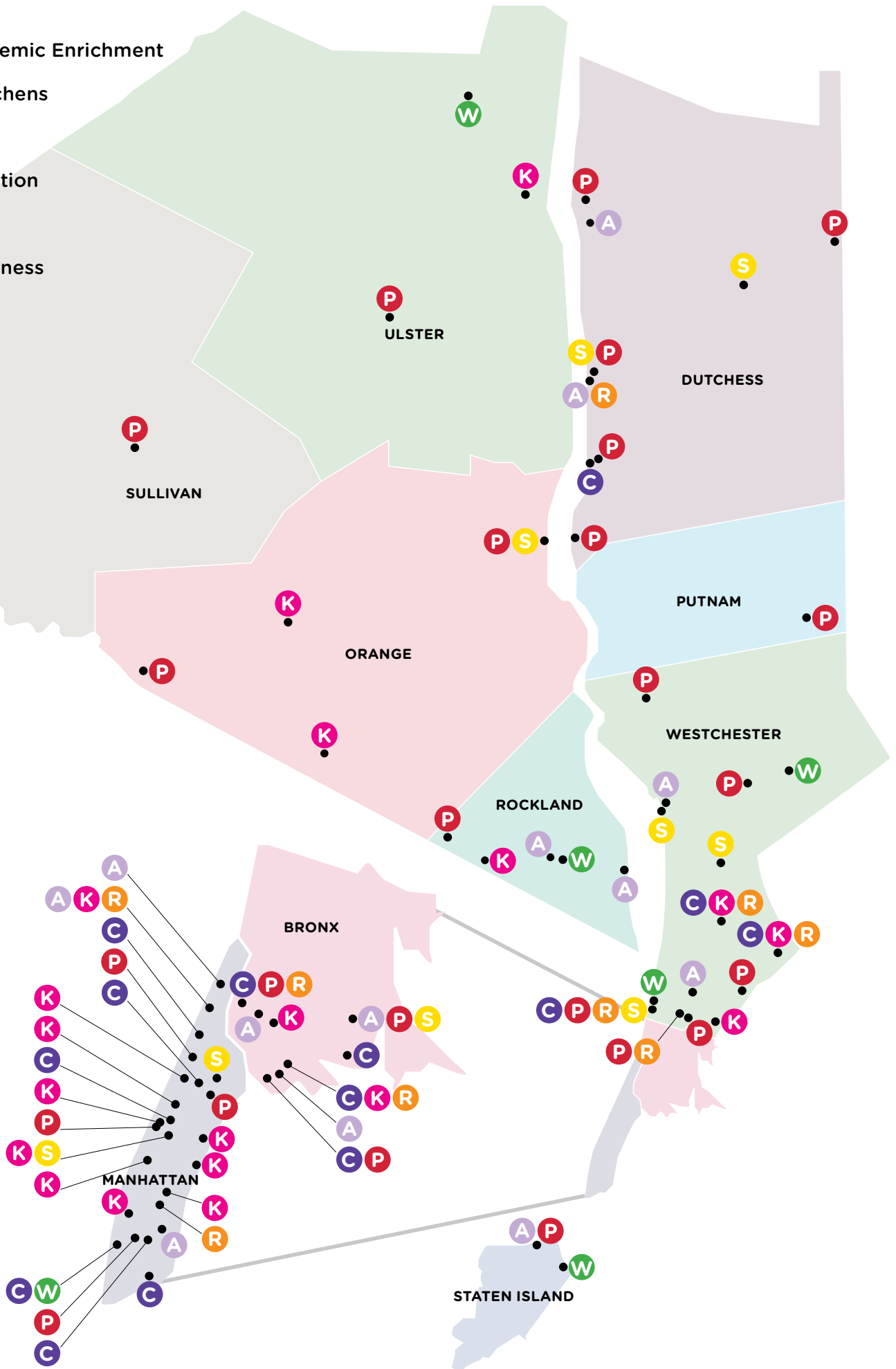

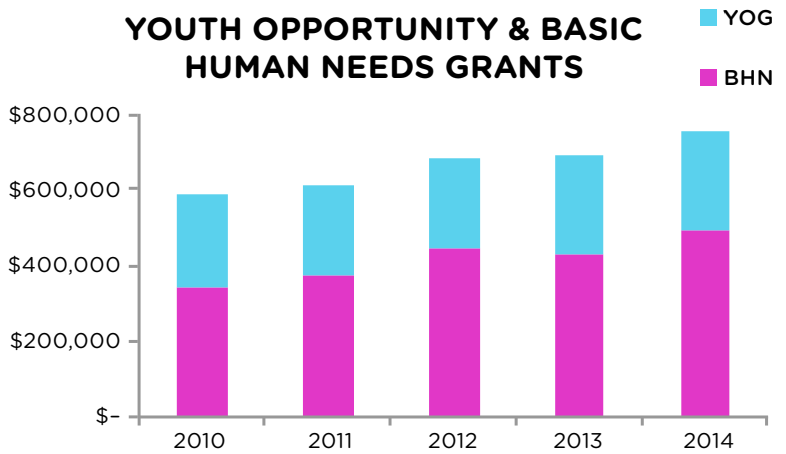
